### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- All anglers MUST fish with rod and reel and your feet in the sand. There will be no help with fishing except for gaffing a fish. No nets allowed.
- 2. This is an individual tournament. Anglers will be expected to use the HONOR SYSTEM.
- There will be no limit to the amount of poles that can be fished. Anglers must maintain their own poles and tackle.
- 4. Tie breaker for identical weight fish in a category to be determined by overall length.
- Weigh-in will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, October 20, 2019 at the Fessenden Center. You must register with a CCFW Official to weigh your catch between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. No registration will be allowed after 9:00 a.m.
- 6. Any violations of rules 1 through 5 will disqualify the offending angler.
- All decisions will be made by the CCFW
   Tournament Judges and are final. CCFW
   reserves the right to inspect and/or disqualify any
   fish or angler.
- Anglers may weigh their catch at any North Carolina Weigh Station or CCFW Weigh Station. Anglers must use entry / weight slip stating: overall length, species, weight, time the fish was caught, the weigh station, and the person registering the fish. The angler must present fish for inspection during weigh-in. No frozen or mutilated fish allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- CCFW Weigh Stations will be manned from 9 AM to 6 PM Saturday (at discretion of Weigh Master) at locations to be announced at Tournament Rules meeting.
- For tournament registration purposes, CCFW
   Officials will only weigh and enter fish that are
   legal to possess and/or within slot limits.
